Today your child is bringing home a copy of *The Three Little Pigs*, which we have read in class. The children have loved the story and have acted it out in class. Being able to recall the proper sequence of events in a favorite book is an important reading skill called comprehension. By letting your child retell a story like the *Three Little Pigs*, you are giving him/her practice remembering the story's correct sequence of events. As you listen to your child, add details and events he/she may be missing. Introduce/use/discuss more complex vocabulary words in the story. (EX: meadow, squeezed, stream, stew)
