E-Learning Day Choice Board

Read a book with a family member, friend, or stuffed animal. Talk about what is happening in the story as you read it!	Get a piece of paper and a pencil and see how many shapes you can find in your house! Draw the shapes you find!	Build me a fort! Let's hang out in a fort! It can be made with blankets! Get creative!	Practice writing your name! Remember- sky to the ground, pull straight down when you write your letters!
Find things around your house you can use to count. Cars, barbies, crackers, legos, etc.	Practice being responsible- Pick a chore to help keep the house clean!	Dance to some fun music, or follow along with a brain-break video to get your body moving!	Sing some songs you have been learning at school!
Can you build an obstacle course or draw a hopscotch game?	Get some fresh air and go play outside! There is so much you can do in the sunshine!	Draw a picture and write about a fun activity you did today; remember: writing can be letters you know, or you can ask an adult to help you!	Practice taking turns by playing a board game or a card game!
