- Homecoming Dance (to follow FB game until 11:30 PM) in Auxiliary Gym

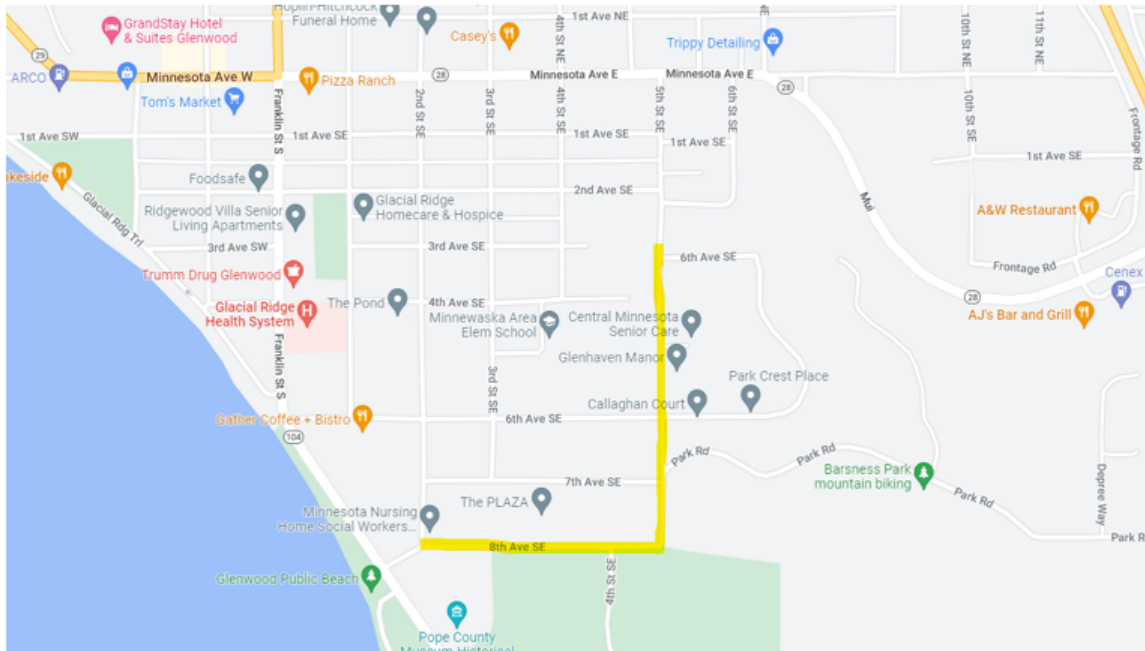
