(Not Jr. High Girls Basketball)

Please ensure your athlete has a physical on file for the official start and the beginning of the winter season. Typically, 7th and 10th-grade student-athletes need a physical to participate in an MSHSL sport. Athletes will not be able to practice until a physical with documentation is submitted or on file. Also, online registration for Laker Activities must be completed before the opening day of practice.
