Early Childhood Screening

Early Childhood Screening is a free & simple check of how your child is growing, developing & learning. *It is best done when your child is 3 years old*. It is also a requirement for any child entering school in Minnesota. It is designed to ensure the healthy growth of students to be successful in any educational setting and if needed, connect them to resources that will support their development.

At your child's screening appointment, a trained professional will check:

- Hearing & vision
- · Growth, immunizations & movement
- · Thinking, language & communication skills
- · Social & emotional development

Early Childhood Screenings are done by the Minnewaska School District and are free of charge.

Online Registration for 2024-2025 School Year is Open!

Each year we ask that you log into your parent vue account and register your child for the next school year. Make sure you select register for the 2024-2025 school year. All data is saved from the first time you register, so it goes rather quickly! It allows you to update any address changes, email addresses, new phone numbers, emergency contacts and even medical information for your student(s).

If you have a student that will be in Kindergarten this fall, we ask that you register as soon as possible so we can plan for adequate staffing. If you don't have a ParentVue account, you will need an activation code from the school office. Please reach out to Kylie Murken at 320.634.4567 ext 2202 or kmurken@isd2149.org and I'll be more than happy to help! Below are the instructions for registering your child online;

In a browser of your choice, locate Minnewaska Area Schools website: https://www.minnewaska.kl2.mn.us/

Select "Enroll and Register" at the top of the main page. Select "Access Online Enrollment Here"

If you already have a Parentvue account, log in.

If not, choose "More Options" then choose "Activate Account"
Select "I Accept" Then use your activation code and follow prompts to create your Parent
Vue account. (IF you do not have an activation code you need to contact the office)

Once you are at the "HOME" screen, you should see any students that the district has attached to you in the center of the screen. In the upper right of this screen, choose the "On-Line Enrollment" option.

The system will walk you through the enrollment process for each of the children you want to enroll at Minnewaska Area Schools for the 24-25 SY.

Class Placement Input Form

As we prepare for the upcoming school year, we frequently receive inquiries from parents regarding our classroom assignment process. Our main objective is to establish conducive learning environments that cater to the diverse needs of all our students. Many factors play into our process for determining classes, including gender, and mixed ability groupings which prompts us to use data on each child's social, emotional, and academic



skills. For these reasons we are unable to honor requests for specific teachers or friend requests. We do welcome parent input through a Placement Input Form which you can find on our website under "Elementary School". This form is a way for you to express your child's unique learning needs. Forms must be returned to the Elementary Office by Friday, May 3rd.


